School Streets Trial

Dear Families,

You will have seen the letter that went out by email and Class Dojo this week about the School Streets proposal for the roads at the back of school. School Streets is a new approach to improve road safety and air quality outside schools, whereby they are closed to traffic at the start and end of the school day. This helps to reduce congestion and improve air quality at the school gates. We have been chosen to trial a School Street road closure scheme. This is because of ongoing problems with drivers parking dangerously, illegally, and inconsiderately, putting children's safety at risk. The proposal is that Montfort Drive and part of Lopham Street will become one-way streets. They will also be closed to traffic be 8:15 to 9:15am in the morning and 14:45 to 15:45pm in the afternoon on school days. The letter sent out earlier this week gives more details about this, and also gives information about how you can share you opinions about the proposal. 
