In this section, we celebrate a particular event, achievement or area of the curriculum each week.

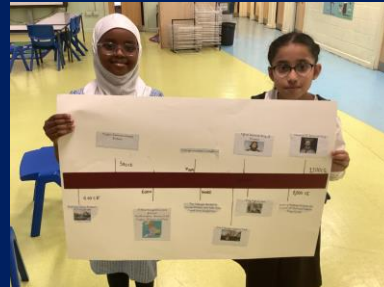
