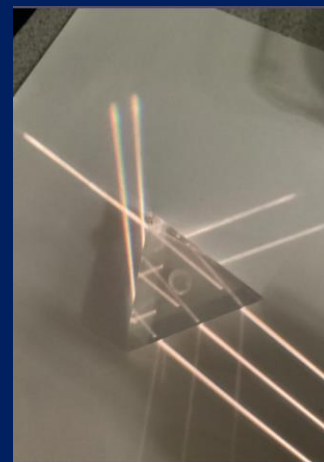
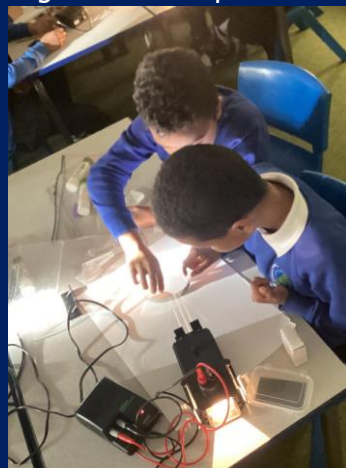
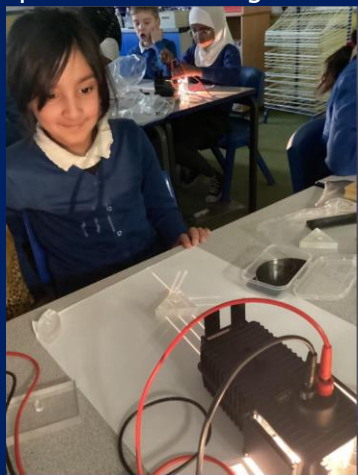
"Allergens and intolerance"
