I would like to remind you that the School Streets closure and one-way road systems starts this Monday, 10th February.

Montfort Drive will become one way at ALL times, with No Entry to vehicles from the direction of Lopham Street. Montfort Drive will also be closed to all unauthorised vehicles at the beginning and end of the school day.

School Streets are a Sheffield City Council led initiative put in place to help keep children safe as they arrive and leave the school. They aim to do this by reducing the number of parked cars and moving vehicles in the busy areas around the school.

We have been working with the council for a long time to achieve this and we hope that all parent/carers will get behind this initiative to help keep our children safe!
